Object: Collège Notre-Dame closed until March 19, 2021

Dear parents and guardians,

The health and safety of students and employees remains the Conseil scolaire catholique Nouvelon's priority.

Due to the declaration of a second COVID-19 case at Collège Notre-Dame (Sudbury) by Public Health Sudbury and Districts and in order to ensure the safety of students and staff, Collège Notre-Dame will remain closed until Friday, March 19, 2021. At the moment, students are expected to resume their learning at school on Monday, March 22, 2021. If this return date should change, the Conseil will inform you of details.

To support students in their learning, grade 9 to 12 students from Collège Notre-Dame will be able to pursue their learning at home in a virtual format until their return to the classroom. Teachers will communicate with students and families through the Students' Portal (Portail élèves) and the Parents' Portal (Portail parents) to inform them of the upcoming steps and explain how this will unfold. The distribution of technological tools is expected to take place in the coming days according to the needs of families, and always respecting recommendation from Public Health Sudbury and Districts.


