Object: École St-Augustin closed until November 26, 2021

Dear parents and guardians,

The health and safety of students and employees remains the Conseil scolaire catholique Nouvelon's priority. Due to the declaration of COVID-19 cases at École St-Augustin (Garson) by Public Health Sudbury and Districts, École St-Augustin will be closed until Friday, November 26, 2021. At the moment, students are expected to resume their learning at school on Monday, November 29, 2021. If this return date should change, the Conseil will inform you of details.

The daycare located at École St-Augustin will remain open and will maintain its Infant and Toddler Program. The Before and After School Program will resume only on November 29, 2021.

To support students in their learning, Kindergarten to grade 8 students from École St-Augustin will be able to pursue their learning at home in a virtual format until their return to the classroom. Teachers will communicate with students and families through the Students' Portal (Portail élèves) and the Parents' Portal (Portail parents) to inform them of the upcoming steps and explain how this will unfold. The distribution of technological tools is expected to take place in the coming days according to the needs of families, while always respecting recommendation from Public Health Sudbury and Districts.

We ask parents who have concerns to contact the Principal of École St-Augustin at 705-693-2424.

Thank you for your continued collaboration with the implementation of public health protocols.

Please note as well that we will continue to publish important news in the Parents' Portal. We invite you to refer to it regularly to stay abreast of the most recent developments in the situation.
