Object: École St-Pierre closed until November 30, 2021

Dear parents and quardians,

The health and safety of students and employees remains the Conseil scolaire catholique Nouvelon's priority. Due to the declaration of COVID-19 cases at École St-Pierre (Sudbury) by Public Health Sudbury and Districts, École St-Pierre will be closed from Tuesday, November 23, to Tuesday, November 30, 2021. At the moment, students are expected to resume their learning at school on Wednesday, December 1, 2021. If this return date should change, the Conseil will inform you of details.

We also wish to inform families that the daycare located at École St-Pierre will also be closed from November 23 to November 30, 2021.

To support students in their learning, Kindergarten to grade 8 students from École St-Pierre will be able to pursue their learning at home in a virtual format until their return to the classroom. Teachers will communicate with students and families through the Students' Portal (Portail élèves) and the Parents' Portal (Portail parents) to inform them of the upcoming steps and explain how this will unfold. The distribution of technological tools is expected to take place in the coming days according to the needs of families, while always respecting recommendation from Public Health Sudbury and Districts.

Thank you for your continued collaboration with the implementation of public health protocols.
