Object: École St-Dominique closed until November 29, 2021

Dear parents and guardians,

The health and safety of students and employees remains the Conseil scolaire catholique Nouvelon's priority. Due to the declaration of COVID-19 cases at École St-Dominique (Sudbury) by Public Health Sudbury and Districts, École St-Dominique will be closed until Monday, November 29, 2021. At the moment, students are expected to resume their learning at school on Tuesday, November 30, 2021. If this return date should change, the Conseil will inform you of details.

We also wish to inform families that the daycare located at École St-Dominique will also be closed until November 29, 2021.

To support students in their learning, Kindergarten to grade 6 students from École St-Dominique will be able to pursue their learning at home in a virtual format until their return to the classroom. Teachers will communicate with students and families through the Students' Portal (Portail élèves) and the Parents' Portal (Portail parents) to inform them of the upcoming steps and explain how this will unfold. The distribution of technological tools is expected to take place in the coming days according to the needs of families, while always respecting recommendation from Public Health Sudbury and Districts.


We ask parents who have concerns to contact the Principal of École St-Dominique at 705-566-2616.
