Object: CSC Nouvelon schools closed until at least January 17, 2022

Dear parents and guardians,

As announced on January 3, 2022, the Ontario government, in consultation with the Chief Medical Officer of Health, has made the decision to move all elementary and secondary schools in the province to remote learning until at least Monday, January 17, 2022. This decision has been made in response to the rapid increase in COVID-19 cases. Therefore, all Conseil scolaire catholique Nouvelon elementary and secondary schools will be closed for in person learning. For more information on services offered by daycares located in our schools, parents are encouraged to communicate with the service providers.

To support students in their learning, Kindergarten to grade 12 students will pursue their learning at home in a virtual format starting in the next few days. Teachers will communicate with students and families through the **Students' Portal** (Portail élèves) and the **Parents' Portal** (Portail parents) to inform them of the upcoming steps and explain how this will unfold. Resources to support students and parents with their virtual learning are available in the Parents' Portal and Students' Portal. The distribution of technological tools is expected to take place in the next few days according to the needs of families, and always respecting recommendations from Public Health Sudbury and Districts, Public Health Algoma and Porcupine Health Unit.


